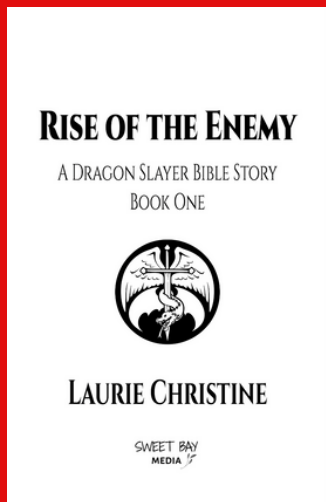

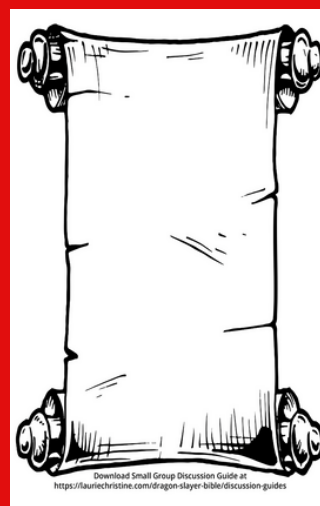
THE MISSION: PART I

BASIC TRAINING

Deuteronomy 4:39

³⁹ Remember this and keep it firmly in mind: The Lord is God both in heaven and on earth, and there is no other.

Nehemiah 9:6

⁶ You alone are the Lord. You made the skies and the heavens and all the stars. You made the earth and the seas and everything in them. You preserve them all, and the angels of heaven worship you.

HAVE YOU JOINED THE ARMY?

Courageous warrior, have you joined the army of the Dragon Slayer? Have you committed your life to serve him and fight for his kingdom?

In the Garden of Eden, Adam and Eve chose to believe the dragon's lie instead of God's truth. As a result, their hearts were filled with an evil called sin. Every human since then has been born with the sickness of sin in their hearts.

Sin is not just the bad things you do or the ways you disobey God. Sin is buried deep in your heart. We can't measure up to God's perfect standard.

Sometimes angels appear to humans and look like humans. (Hebrews 13:2)

Angels worship God in Heaven. (Revelation 5:11-12)

When the Bible mentions the "angel of the Lord," it's actually talking about Jesus! (Genesis 22:15-18; Exodus 3:1-5)

Angels should not be worshipped. (Revelation 19:10)
